

SCIENTIFIC CONFERENCE: “FISCAL POLICY AND INNOVATION IN ECONOMIC GROWTH MODEL IN THE NEW CONTEXT”

On the morning of November 29, 2024, the University of Finance – Marketing (UFM) successfully held a scientific conference titled “Fiscal Policy and Innovation in Economic Growth Model in the New Context”, hosted by the Faculty of Public Management – Real Estate.

Attending the conference were: Dr. Lê Trung Đạo, Vice Rector of UFM; Assoc. Prof. Dr. Huỳnh Thế Nguyễn, Head of the Department of Scientific Research Management; leaders and lecturers of the Faculty of Public Management – Real Estate; lecturers from various departments within the university; scientists from both inside and outside UFM (such as University of Economics Ho Chi Minh City, Saigon University, Van Hien University, etc.); and students from the Faculty of Public Management – Real Estate participating in scientific research.

The conference focused on the topic of innovating the economic growth model, an issue emphasized since the 11th National Party Congress (2011), which called for shifting the growth model from primarily extensive growth to a combination of extensive and intensive growth—expanding in scale while improving quality, efficiency, and sustainability. In Vietnam, although there have been some changes in the growth model, they remain limited and have not brought about fundamental transformation. Productivity, quality, efficiency, and competitiveness of the economy remain relatively low.

Against this backdrop, the conference received many meaningful and practical contributions from participants, offering policy implications aimed at achieving the economic growth goals for the 2021–2030 period. These goals include rapid and sustainable economic growth, with a focus on enhancing growth quality through new highlights such as the green economy, circular economy, and digital economy—contributing to the national aspiration that by 2030, Vietnam becomes “a developing country with modern industry and upper-middle income” and by 2045, “a developed, high-income country.”
